

# The Hyatt Regency Hotel

This memorable luxury resort in Vietnam is situated on a tranquil stretch of white sandy beach, at the gateway to the vibrant city of Danang, an ideal base to explore the exotic charms of Central Vietnam no matter the occasion, from meetings and events to memorable family vacations.

The Regency Suite of the Hyatt Regency Danang Resort and Spa comes with 84sqm of homely space - the design is clean, subtle and inviting, exactly how a luxury home with a view of the ocean should be. The hotel utilizes a lot of wood which is locally sourced and you will see the authenticity across the rooms.

The living space is extensive with comfortable sofas, dining table, study tables and a fully fitted mini-kitchen. For those travelling with families, the hotel has rooms that connect to the living spaces, thus giving families the comforts of home in a hotel.

The Regency Suite has two balconies that are not connected - one via the living room

and one via the bedroom. The first thing anyone should do when they get into their room in a resort is to check out the view - nothing screams a great vacation like the soothing sound of waves crashing on the shore.

The particular suite that I was in also had a view of the main swimming pool (there are five different pools in the resort!) which had a shallower area for kids to play at.

Within steps you'll find Non Nuoc Beach and Marble Mountains within a 10-minute stroll. Highlights at this beachfront resort include 3 restaurants, 2 outdoor swimming pools, and a full-service spa. All 375 rooms feature LCD TVs with cable channels, and

you can enjoy free WiFi, coffee/tea makers, and ceiling fans. Dining in is an option with 24-hour room service, and minibars provide refreshments. Additionally, room service, safes, and irons/ironing boards are available.

A day of pampering can include massages, aromatherapy, and mani/pedis along with access to the spa tub. The restaurant, Green House, serves Italian cuisine and is open for breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

For a drink, you can stop by the resort's own bar/lounge. Spend the day at the private beach where you'll find cabanas, and enjoy the onsite health club and kids' club. Business travelers can take advantage

of 7 meeting rooms, a conference centre, and a business centre. Plus you'll find free WiFi in public areas, a sauna, and a kids' swimming pool. Each morning buffet breakfast is served between 6:30 AM and 10:30 AM. There's also free self parking, along with the convenience of train pick-up service.

Within a 30-minute drive of this 4.5-star Hoa Hai resort, attractions include Hoi

An Ancient Town and Museum of Cham Sculpture.

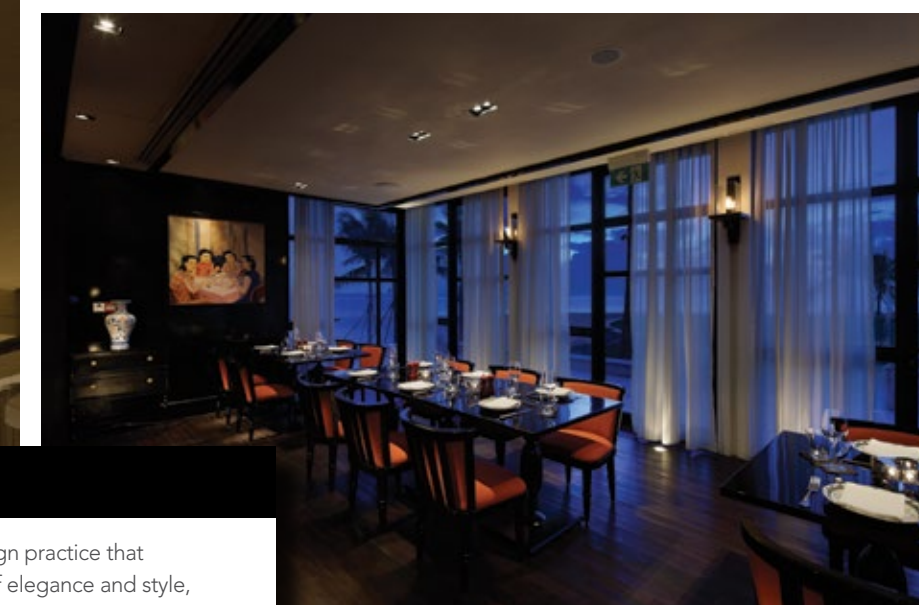
